Petition of citizens of Dorchester and Caroline counties, for a law preventing the sale of, within one mile of Federalsburg, unless the person applying for a license to sell, shall obtain the recommendation of two-thirds of the citizens of said village, referred 233; committee discharged from its consideration 253.

Petition of citizens of Washington county, for a law to prevent the sale of intoxication drinks on the Sabbath, referred 266; similar petition 337.

Petition of citizens of Talbot county, for an act in relation to the sale of ardent spirits, upon the terms therein mentioned, referred 345.

Petition of citizens of Allegany county, to prevent the sale of, within three miles of Mount Savage Iron Works, referred 401.

Petition of citizens of Calvert county, for a modification of the law regulating the sale of ardent spirits, referred 402.
