

TANEYTOWN ACADEMY.—Leave granted to report a bill to incorporate the trustees of, 93; bill reported and passed 104; sent to the senate 106; returned, passed with amendments, which are assented to and the bill ordered to be engrossed 167.

Petition of citizens of Taneytown for a donation to the, referred 368.

TAXES—Treasurer ordered to report the amount of direct, due from each county, Baltimore city and Howard District for the years 1841, '42 and '43, 19.

Leave asked to report a bill to separate the collection of State and county, so far as Calvert county is concerned, referred to the committee on ways and means 38; the committee directed to report on or before 25th January 49.

Committee on ways and means directed to report, what alterations are necessary in the law to enforce sales of real estate for, 44.

Resolution from the committee of ways means, expressive of the sense of the legislature that the public interest would be promoted by the governor forbearing to put in suit the bonds of the collectors of the direct, until 15th of April next, proposed 60; substitute offered and rejected 74; amended and assented to 74—75; sent to the senate *ib*; returned assented to 108.

Petition of William Dellinger, late collector of State, for Washington county, praying that a law may be passed, authorising him as collector, and with all the usual powers, to collect the State, for said county for the years 1841 and '42, as far as the same may remain uncollected and to pay one moiety thereof to the treasurer, on or before the 1st day of September next, and the other moiety, on or before the last Monday of December next, received and referred 65; bill reported and referred 144; reported, passed and sent to the senate 188; returned passed and ordered to be engrossed 258.

Leave granted to report a bill to authorise Isaac C. Anderson, late sheriff and collector of, in Howard District, to continue the collection of the arrears of, of said district for the years 1841 and '42, 71; bill reported, passed and sent to the senate 72; returned, passed 80.

Leave asked to report a bill to separate the collection of the State and county, so far as Worcester county is concerned, motion to refer to the Worcester delegation negatived and a motion to refer to the committee on ways and means, carried 72.
