Mr. Chapman, chairman of the committee on Corporations, to which was referred the bill from the Senate entitled, a further supplement to the act to incorporate the Baltimore Insurance company, reported the same without amendment;

The said bil! was then read the first and second time by special

order, and passed.

Mr. Chapman, chairman of the coumittee on Corporation, reported a bill entitled, an act for the extension and renewal of the charter of the Farmers Bank of Maryland and Branches, and for other purposes;

Which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table. The House then resumed the consideration of the unfinished business of yesterday, being the bill reported by Mr. Yellott, chairman of the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice, entitled, a supplement to the act regulating writs of error and granting appeals to the Court of Appeals.

The question before the House being upon the motion of Mr. Calvert, to amend said bill by adding at the end thereof, the fol-

lowing proviso:

"Provided that the Court of Appeals make no objection there-

to.

Mr. Calvert having withdrawn his motion, moved that said bill be referred to the consideration of the next General Assembly of Maryland;

Determined in the negative

The question then recurred and was put,

"Shall the said bill pass?"

Resolved in the affirmative.

On motion of Mr Hopewell,

The House adjourned until Monday morning 12 o'clock.
