On motion of Mr. Morsell,

Ordered, That the committee on Inspections enquire into the expediency of requiring the inspector of plaster of paris in the city of Baltimore, to be a practical chemist, and whether the services of such an individual could be obtained for the amount now arising from the inspection of that article, and report by bill or otherwise.

Mr. Thomson, from the select committee, reported a bill entitled, an act to authorise the burgess and commissioners of Taneytown to sell certain property therein mentioned ;

Which were severally read the first and by a special order the second time, passed, and sent to the Senate.
