Mr. Graves reported a bill entitled, a supplement to an act to erect Baltimore town, in Baltimore county, into a city, and to incorporate the inhabitants thereof;

Ordered, That the register of wills of the city of Baltimore, and of each of the counties of this State and Howard District, be and they are hereby required to report to this House, on or before the 15th day of February next, the aggregate amount upon which commissions have been allowed to executors and administrators by the orphans' court of their respective counties and Howard district, for the years 1843 and 1844, respectively; and also, the aggregate sum of money allowed by way of commissions to executors and administrators by said respective courts, and that the clerks of the several county courts as courts of equity, and the register of the chancery court, report the aggregate amounts that have been allowed to trustees and receivers for commissions during the same period.
