or owners of mill or mills, by reason of the draining of such swamp or swamps, if any; and the said court on confirmation of such return shall pass such order or orders for the payment of such damage to the owner or owners of such mill or mills as shall to them

appear right and proper in the premises.

Sec. 17. And be it enacted, That in case of the property or interest of any minor or minors being effected by the draining of any swamp or low land as hereinbefore provided for by this act, the court before whom such proceedings may have been had on being informed of the interests of such minor or minors being effected by such proceedings, shall appoint a guardian or guardians for such minor or minors for the protection of the interests of their respective ward or wards.

Sec. 18. And be it enacted, That in case of any owner or owners of lands or other property effected by the operation of the provisions of this act living out of this State, a written notice of thirty days served on the tenant or tenants agent or agents of such owner or owners, of the proceedings of the commissioners as hereinbefore provided for, shall be as good and sufficient as if the said owner or owners of such land or other property were residents of this State.

On motion of Mr. Worthington, of Baltimore county, The House reconsidered the 1st section of the bill.

Mr. Worthington, of Baltimore county, moved to amend said bill by inserting the words "Worcester county," after the word "grounds ?"

On motion of Mr. Fooks, belowed

Said bill and amendment were laid on the table.

The bill reported by Mr. Graves entitled, an act to reduce the number of commissioners of insolvent debtors for the city of Baltimore.

Was taken up for consideration, and read the second time.
