

Which were severally read the first and by a special order the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Lankford, from the committee on Corporations, entitled, an act further to continue an act passed at December session 1831, entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Chesapeake Steam Towing Company,

Was taken up for consideration;

On motion of Mr. Biser,

Said bill was amended by adding at the end thereof as an additional section, the following:

"Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the General Assembly retains to itself the power at any time to alter, change or repeal this act;"

The said bill having been read through as amended, was passed and sent to the Senate.

The bill reported by Mr. Gallagher, chairman of the committee on Corporations, entitled, an act to incorporate the members of the Baltimore Club,

Was taken up for consideration;

Read the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

The clerk of the Senate returned the bill entitled, an act to allow Jacob Clemmer further time to complete his collections;

Also, the bill entitled, an act to allow Washington Finley, collector of Queen Anne's county, further time to complete his collections;

Also, the bill entitled, an act to make valid the proceedings of Edward M. Wise, Esq. a justice of the peace of Somerset county;

Also, the bill entitled, a further supplement to the act, enlarging the powers of the high court of chancery;

Also, the bill entitled, an act for the benefit of Thomas A. Roberts, of Cecil county, allowing him further time to complete his collections;

Also, the bill entitled, an act to alter and change the name of Laura Ogle Oldham, of Cecil county, to Laura Ogle;

Also, the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the "Merchants Shot Tower of Baltimore;"

Severally endorsed, "will pass," and the bills severally ordered to be engrossed.

Also, the bill entitled, an act to limit the number of judges in Baltimore city court to two;

Endorsed "will not pass."

And delivered a bill originated in and passed by the Senate, entitled, an act to allow John M. Carlton, late sheriff and collector of fees of Allegany county, further time to complete his collections;

Which, on motion of Mr. Fitzpatrick,

Was read the first, and by a special order the second time, passed and returned to the Senate.

Also, delivered the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Howard Manufacturing company of Maryland;
