

On motion of Mr. Williams, of Baltimore city,

Mr. Morsell, chairman of the committee on Retrenchment, to which was referred the resolution from the Senate, relative to the disposal of certain furniture in the government house, reported the same with the following amendment.

Amendment proposed.

Strike out all after the word "useless," and insert "and pay the proceeds thereof into the treasury."

The said resolution was then read the second time by special order, "assented to," with the proposed amendment, and the resolution returned to the Senate.

On motion of Mr. Stewart,

Leave was granted the Anne Arundel county delegation, to bring in a bill supplementary to an act passed at December session 1842, ch. 72, entitled, an act relating to Anne Arundel county.

The Speaker laid before the House a report from the register of wills for Anne Arundel county, in obedience to the order of the House of Delegates of 29th January;

Which was read and referred to the committee on Ways and Means.

On motion of Mr. Springer,

The House adjourned until to-morrow morning 10 o'clock.
