

or restrained," and inserting in lieu thereof the words, "and the company hereby incorporated shall be subject to all the restrictions imposed."

Pending these motions,

The Speaker announced that the hour had arrived for taking up the order of the day,

The House then resumed the consideration of the bill reported by Mr. Johnson, of Frederick, chairman of the select committee on the Chesapeake and Ohio canal company, entitled, an act to provide for the completion of the Chesapeake and Ohio Canal to Cumberland, and for other purposes ;

On motion of Mr. Bowie,

The House resolved itself into a committee of the Whole House upon said bill, (Mr. Kilgour being in the Chair,) and after some time spent in committee, the Speaker resumed the Chair, and the Chairman reported, that the said committee had in obedience to order, had said bill under consideration, and having made some progress therein, had directed him to ask leave to sit again, which leave was granted by the House.

The House then adjourned until 4 o'clock, P. M.
