

Mr. Johnson, of Anne Arundel, from the select committee reported a bill entitled, an act to allow William Bryan, trustee of William and Lewis N. Sewell, further time to complete his collections;

Mr. Stewart from the select committee, reported a bill entitled, an act supplementary to an act entitled, an act to change the commencement of the March term of the court of Howard District court of Anne Arundel county;

Mr. Purnell from the select committee, reported a bill entitled, an act to enable James Powell, former sheriff of Worcester county, to make a special return; and

Mr. Worthington, of Anne Arundel, from the select committee, reported a bill entitled, an act to extend an act relating to justices of the peace in Baltimore city to Anne Arundel county and Howard District;

Which were severally read the first and by a special order the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Lynch from the select committee, to which was referred the bill from the Senate, entitled, an act to divide primary school district No. 2. of Anne Arundel county, made a favorable report upon said bill;

Which was read the first and by a special order the second time, passed and returned to the Senate.

Mr. Gallagher, chairman of the committee on Corporations, reported a bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Mutual Fire Insurance Company of Baltimore;

Mr. Morsell from the committee on Inspections, reported a bill entitled, an act for the appointment of wheat inspector in the city of Baltimore;

Mr. Graves from the committee on Ways and Means, reported a bill entitled, an act supplementary to an act entitled, an act declaratory of the act of the General Assembly, passed at December session 1841, ch. 325; and

Mr. Morsell from the committee on Inspections, reported a bill entitled, an act relating to the inspection of lumber in the city of Annapolis;

Which were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Gallagher, chairman of the committee on Corporations, to which was referred the bill from the Senate, entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Cuba Smelting and Mining Company, made a favorable report thereof;

Which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Gallagher reported a bill entitled, an act to authorise H. Allen Taylor, of the city of Baltimore, to bring to this State certain slaves for life;

Which was read the first and by a special order the second time.
