Mr. Williams, of Baltimore city, presented the memorial of the President and Directors of the Fell's Point Savings Institution of Baltimore, for the renewal of the charter;

Which was read and referred to the committee on Corporations.

Mr. Williams, of Baltimore city, also presented the petition of William Wallace, B. Deford & Co., praying the repeal of certain acts of assembly, therein mentioned;

Which was read and referred to the Baltimore city delegation.

The Speaker laid before the House, a report from the clerk of Prince George's county, relative to the attendance of judges;
