

Also, a bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Mutual Life Insurance Company of Baltimore;

Also, a bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Paradise Company;

Which were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Morsell from the select committee, to which was referred the bill from the Senate, entitled, an act to keep in repair the public roads in Calvert county, reported the same with the following amendment:

Amendment proposed.

Insert as the 3rd section of the bill, the following:

"Sec. 3. And be it further enacted, That said levy court be, and they are hereby authorised and empowered, (if in their judgment it be to the interest of the county,) to put up annually all section or hundred of public roads in said county, to the lowest bidder or bidders, and to pay upon the assessable property of the county for said purpose, with full power to withhold the amount or amounts so levied in case said bidder or bidders, do not keep said roads in good repair, and they are hereby authorised for the better carrying out the purposes of this section, to divide the county into as many sections or hundreds as they may deem expedient;"

Which was read and assented to.

The said bill was then read the second time, by a special order passed with the proposed amendment, and returned to the Senate.

On motion of Mr. Hollyday, of Cecil,

The House took up for consideration, the bill entitled, an act to make valid a certain deed of conveyance therein mentioned;

Which was read the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

Mr. Long from the select committee, made a favorable report upon the bill from the Senate, entitled, a further supplement to the act of 1841, ch. 270, to promote the preservation, improvement and increase of shell fish within this State;

Mr. Springer reported a bill entitled, an additional supplement to the act passed December session 1844, entitled, an act supplementary to an act for the weighing of anthracite, and measuring of bituminous coal, passed at December session 1837, chapter 316; and

Mr. Muse reported a bill entitled, an act to make valid a deed from the Rev. Thomas Bayne and Eliza C. his wife, of Talbot county, to the Rev. John C. Waggaman, of Jefferson county, Pennsylvania;

Which were severally read the first, and by a special order the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.
