The House met.

Also, the bill entitled, an act to incorporate the Gray Manufacturing Company;

Also, the bill entitled, an act for the benefit of Daniel Badley, of Somerset county;

Also, the bill entitled, a supplement to an act passed at December session 1843, ch. 308;

Also, the bill entitled, an act to authorise the levy court of Frederick county, in their discretion to apply to the repairs of the court house in said county, the money heretofore levied for the erection of a new court house in said county;

Also, the bill entitled, an act for the relief of William Motter, of Frederick county;

Also, the bill entitled, an act authorising the construction of a bridge across Barren Creek, at or near Barren Creek Springs, Somerset county;

Also, the bill entitled, an act to authorise Thomas M. D. Baden, former collector of Prince George's county, further time to complete his collections;

Severally endorsed "will pass," and the bills severally ordered to be engrossed.

Also, the bill entitled, an act to repeal the office of commissioners of tax, for Frederick county, and for other purposes;

Endorsed, "will pass with the proposed amendment;"

Which amendment was twice read, "assented to," and the bill ordered to be engrossed;
