

Leave was granted the committee on Colored Population, to repeal so much of an act passed at December session 1836, as exempts Anne Arundel and Baltimore counties, from the operation of the law specified in said act.

On motion of Mr. Potter,

Leave was granted the Caroline delegation, to bring in a bill for the safe custody of the school funds of Caroline county.

On motion of Mr. Ware,

Leave was granted the Baltimore county delegation, to bring in a bill to repeal the second section of an act passed December session 1838, chapter 263.

Mr. Gallagher, chairman of the committee on Corporations, to which was referred the bill from the Senate entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Cumberland Coal and Iron Company, passed at December session 1840, ch. 214, reported the same without amendment;

The said bill was then read the first, and by a special order the second time, passed and returned to the Senate.

Mr. Harrison reported a bill entitled, an act supplementary to an act to allow Thomas H. Ford, former sheriff of Queen Anne's county, further time to complete his collections;

Which was read the first and by a special order the second time, passed and sent to the Senate.

On motion of Mr. Johnson, of A. A.

Ordered, That the Treasurer ascertain and report to this House at the earliest practicable period, the reasons which have occasioned a failure on the part of the Susquehanna canal company, and the Tide Water canal company, to comply with the provisions of the act of December session 1843, chapter 363, and the mortgages and bonds executed by them in conformity therewith.

Mr. Kilgour, chairman of the committee on Claims, delivered a report upon the accounts of Dennis Claude, Esq., Treasurer of the State :

Which was read and referred to the committee on Ways and Means.

Mr. Gallagher chairman of the committee on Corporations, made a favorable report upon the bill reported by Mr. Thomson, entitled, an act to incorporate the trustees of the Evangelical Lutheran Congregation of Taneytown, in Carroll county ;

Also, from the same committee, made a favorable report upon the bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Superannuated Fund Society of the Maryland Annual Conference, passed at December session 1839, chapter 285 ;

And reported a bill entitled, an act to continue the charter of the Fell's Point Savings Institution of Baltimore ;

Which were severally read the first time, and ordered to lie on the table.
