

Mr. Randall offered the following as a substitute:

"Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That from and after the passage of this act, any person voting or offering to vote in any of the counties in this State or in the city of Baltimore or in Howard District, knowing himself not to be a legal voter at the time of so voting or offering to vote, or any person bribing or offering to bribe a voter, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof in the county court of the county in which said voting or offering to vote, or bribing or offering to bribe, shall be done or attempted to be done, or in the city of Baltimore or in Howard District, shall be subject to a fine of not less than twenty dollars nor more than one thousand dollars, and to imprisonment in the county jail for not less than one month nor more than six months.

"And be it enacted, That if any person shall influence or attempt to influence, or in any manner control the vote of any legal voter by offering to such voter any reward, or by promises of any advantage whatever, or of giving said voter employment, or by threats of diminishing the wages of such voter, or in any manner directly or indirectly, the person so offending shall upon conviction or indictment in the county or city court or Howard District court, where such offence shall be committed, shall be subject to a fine of not less than fifty dollars nor more than five hundred dollars, and be imprisoned in the county jail for not less than one month nor more than six months."

Mr. Calvert called for the previous question, and being demanded by a majority of the members present, the question was then put,

"Will the House accept the substitute?" and

Determined in the negative.
