And if in his judgment the aforesaid incorporated companies have misused and abused their chartered privileges, he is hereby authorised to institute legal proceedings in Washington county court, requiring said companies to be, and appear in said court by a certain day to be named in the State's writ, to shew cause why the charters of said companies shall not be declared as forfeited.

Mr. Purnell resigned his appointment as the agent to represent the State in all joint stock companies.

The House took up the bill from the Senate entitled, a supplement to the act entitled an act to extend the charters of the several Banks in Baltimore city.

The said bill was then read the second time, passed and returned to the Senate.

The House took up for consideration the bill from the Senate entitled, an act to incorporate the Cumberland, Baltimore and New York steam packet company;

Said bill was read the second time.

Mr. Fitzpatrick moved to amend said bill by adding at the end of the first section, the following:

Provided, that nothing in this act contained, shall be construed to authorize the company hereby incorporated, to establish a line of wagons, stages or other vehicles, for the transportation of passengers, goods, wares or merchandize, on the national road west of the town of Cumberland;

Which was read and adopted.

Mr. Gallagher submitted the following as an additional section to the bill:

And be it enacted, That this corporation shall not be permitted to issue any note, token, device or other evidence of debt, to be used as currency;

Which was read and adopted.

The said bill was then passed as amended, and returned to the Senate.

Mr. Clarke submitted the following resolutions:

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That William T. Goldsborough, of Dorchester county, be and he is hereby appointed agent to vote the stocks of this State in all joint stock companies in which the State has an interest, in the place of Wm. U. Purnell, Esq., who has resigned;

Resolved, That the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Delegates, address a joint letter to the said Wm. T. Goldsborough, informing him of his appointment;
