

CALLICUT, WM. BUTLER AND MARGARET—Leave granted to report a bill making valid deeds and other instruments, made and executed by, aliens by birth, previous to naturalization 44.

CALVERT COUNTY—Leave granted to report a bill to provide for the repairs of the public roads in, 24.

Bill from the senate, for the repair of the public roads of, referred 376; reported with an amendment which is passed and the bill returned to the senate 436.

Leave granted to report a bill to repeal the fifth section of chapter 281 of 1841, in relation to people of color in this State, so far as concerns, 76; bill reported and referred 80; favorable report thereon 243.

Petition of citizens of, and Anne Arundel, praying for a law to protect them from the evils complained of, referred 101.

Leave granted to report a bill to reduce the number of the levy court of, 379.
