

CHESAPEAKE AND OHIO CANAL—

Resolution that the commissioner of loans give his receipt to the president of the, for certain coupons specified, assented to and sent to the senate 226; returned assented to and ordered to be engrossed 245.

Order that the committee on ways and means enquire into the expediency of reporting a bill providing that the principal and interest on the bonds sold at a discount by the, shall be paid, when paid, to the amount of sales of such bonds so far as they may be identified 306.

Resolution submitted asserting the claim of Maryland upon the general government to be reimbursed her expenditure on the, 359.

Bill from the senate supplemental to chapter 297 of 1830, amending the act incorporating the, referred 445; reported amended, the amendments agreed to, the bill passed and returned to the senate 463.

Leave granted to report a bill to repeal chapter 70 of March session 1841, for the completion of the, and referred 459.

Order proposed that the committee to whom said leave was referred enquire into the validity of the \$3,000,000 of sterling bonds issued to the Baltimore and Ohio rail road company, laid on the table 459.

Motion made to suspend the rules to report said bill negatived 459.

Bill reported 462; motion made to suspend the rules to give the bill a second reading *ib*; negatived 465; bill taken up 499; passed and sent to the senate 500; returned passed and ordered to be engrossed 507.

Resolution submitted that the State's agents obtain certain information relative to the negotiation of a loan for the completion of the, passed 500; returned rejected 511.
