Leave granted to report a bill to amend the, so as to substitute biennial for annual sessions of the legislature and referred to a select committee of seven 76; bill reported 103; made the order of the day 215; agreed that it should be taken up 369; taken up and amended 373; the bill passed and sent to the senate 374; returned rejected, message adopted requesting a reconsideration of the bill, and with the bill sent to the senate 468; returned rejected 507.
