

GENERAL ASSEMBLY—

Leave granted to report a bill to regulate the itinerant charges of the members elect of the, and for other purposes 24; bill reported 103; passed and sent to the senate 160; returned rejected 376.

Leave granted to report a bill to reduce the number of members of the, 306.

Order submitted that the house cease to act on house bills, and that all bills remaining undisposed of, be referred to the next, 499; amended and adopted 500.

GENERAL GOVERNMENT—Order adopted that 125 copies of the "correspondence between the Treasurer of the Western Shore and the Third Auditor of the United States Treasury, on the subject of the claim of Maryland upon the, for interest due upon sums advanced by the State during the late war with Great Britain," which took place in 1826, be printed 143.
