To the senate, proposing the appointment of a joint committee on the library, adopted 19; sent to the senate 20.

To the senate, proposing an interchange of services of the chaplains to the two bodies, assented to 21; sent to the senate 25; reply received concurring 29.

From the senate, proposing a joint committee to visit the governor's house, with a view to ascertain the amount necessary to be appropriated to the repair and furnishing of that building 21; reply submitted and assented to 22; sent to the senate 25.
