

TAX—

Mr. Potter asks leave to record his reason for voting against the bill, which is refused 473.

Bill reported declaratory of chapter 325 of 1841, imposing a, on salaries, incomes and emoluments 259; passed and sent to the senate 385; returned passed and ordered to be engrossed 463.

Bill entitled, a further additional supplement to the act for the general valuation and assessment of property in this State and to provide a, to pay the debts of the State, passed at March session eighteen hundred and forty-one chapter 23, reported 232.

Petitions of citizens of Harford county praying a law giving further power to the collectors of the, to enable them more effectually to enforce the collection of the State, referred 78, 246.

Petition of citizens of Prince George's county for a law to impose a, on free negro mechanics, referred 261.

Order adopted that the committee on ways and means enquire into the expediency of so amending the, laws to allow collectors, commissions only on the amounts collected by them 263.

Leave granted to report a bill for the payment of an income, by officers of incorporated companies 263; bill reported 266; unfavorable report and the bill recommitted 293; reported 347; passed and sent to the senate 413; returned passed and ordered to be engrossed 463.

Petition presented for a law to impose a, on voters, referred 272.

Order adopted requiring the committee on ways and means to enquire into the expediency of reporting a bill to ensure the payment of the direct, based upon certain specified suggestions 275.

Bill reported supplemental to the act to facilitate the collection of the portion of the, levied in pursuance of chapter 23 of eighteen hundred and forty-one, passed and sent to the senate 309; returned passed and ordered to be engrossed 423.

Bill reported to make coupons and certificates of interest receivable for taxes without distinction of years 362; passed and sent to the senate 392; returned passed and ordered to be engrossed 464.
