On motion of Mr. Morsell,

Leave was granted the Calvert county delegation to bring in a bill to repeal the 5th section of the Act of Assembly, passed at December session 1831, chapter 281, relating to people of color in this State, so far as relates to Calvert county.

On motion of Mr. Rogers,

Leave was granted the committee on Inspections, to bring in a bill supplementary to an act entitled, an act to provide for the inspection of plaster of paris, passed December session 1832.

On motion of Mr. Kilgour,

Leave was granted to bring in a bill entitled, an act to alter and amend the Constitution and Form of Government of the State of Maryland, so as to substitute biennial for annual sessions of the Legislature, and for other purposes.

Mr. Kilgour moved to refer said leave to a select committee of seven, to be appointed by the Chair.

Mr. Graves moved that said leave be referred to a select committee of twenty-one, to be appointed by the Chair;

Determined in the negative.

The question then recurred and was put, upon the motion of Mr. Kilgour, to refer the leave to a select committee of seven, and Determined in the affirmative.

In pursuance whereof, the Speaker appointed Messrs. Kilgour, Johnson, of Frederick, Archer, Muse, Biser, Calvert and Hollyday, of Cecil, the committee.

On motion of Mr. Hollyday, of Kent,

Leave was granted Messrs. Hollyday, of Kent, Spencer and Tilden, to bring in a bill for the benefit of the crier of Kent county court.

On motion of Mr. Hollyday, of Kent,

Leave was also granted said committee, to bring in a bill relating to the levy court of Kent county.

On motion of Mr. Hollyday, of Kent,

Leave was also granted said committee, to bring in a bill to prescribe the duties and fix the compensation of the jailor in Kent county, in certain cases.

On motion of Mr. Archer,

Leave was granted the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice, to bring in a bill to amend the constitution by restraining the power of the legislature, to pledge the credit of the State for works of internal improvement.
