

The clerk of the Senate returned the bill entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to incorporate the Superannuated Fund Society of the Maryland Annual Conference, passed at December session 1839, chapter 285;

SATURDAY, January 18th, 1845.

The House met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The Speaker laid before the House reports from the trustees of the Rockville academy, in Montgomery county, and the Abingdon academy, in Harford county, relative to the condition of said academies;

Which were severally read and referred to the committee on Education.

The Speaker also laid before the House reports from the register of wills for Anne Arundel and Baltimore counties;

Also, a report from the clerk of Frederick county court, in obedience to the order of the House of Delegates, of the 8th inst.

Which were read and severally referred to the committee on Ways and Means.

Also, laid before the House the following communication from the Treasurer of the State:

TREASURY,

ANNAPOLIS, January 17th, 1845.

To the Honorable

The House of Delegates:

In compliance with the order of the 10th instant, directing the Treasurer, "to ascertain and report to the House at the earliest practicable period, the reasons which have occasioned a failure on the part of the Susquehanna canal company, and the Tide Water canal company, to comply with the provisions of the act of December session 1843, chapter 363, and the mortgages and bonds executed by them in conformity therewith."
