

Mr. Randall submitted the following orders :

Ordered, That the clerk of this House ascertain, without delay, from the several county clerks, where there are no collectors of the State direct taxes, what proceedings (if any,) have been had under the eighth section of chapter 208, of the laws of last session, and that he obtain from them, a copy of all docket entries of suits, against delinquent tax payers, with the costs, so far as they have accrued in said suits.

Ordered also, That the clerk obtain from the clerks of the levy courts or the deputies of the Attorney General of said counties, a copy of delinquent tax payers of said counties, required to be placed annually, by the clerks, of the levy courts, in the hands of the deputies of the Attorney General ;

Which were read,

The first order was read the second time and adopted.

Mr. Long moved to lay the second order on the table ;

Determined in the negative.

Mr. Kilgour, (seconded by two other members that voted in the majority,) moved to reconsider the vote of the House upon the first order ; and

Determined in the affirmative.

Mr. Johnson, of Anne Arundel, then offered as a substitute for said orders the following :

Ordered, That the committee on Grievances and Courts of Justice, enquire and report to this House, at as early a day as practicable, whether in their judgment, the time has yet arrived for the proceedings contemplated by the 8th section of the act of 1843, chapter 208, against the taxable inhabitants of the several counties of this State, and whether further legislation in their judgment, is necessary to effect the purposes designed by the said act ;

Which was read.

On the question being put,

"Will the House accept the substitute ?"

It was resolved in the affirmative.
