

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 53(1) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition and 1968 Supplement), title "Alcoholic Beverages," subtitle "General Provisions on Issue of Licenses," sub-heading "Prince George's County," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, to read as follows:*

53. Prince George's County—Generally.

(1) Number of licenses issued.—The number of licenses of each class of alcoholic beverage licenses in Prince George's County *unless otherwise indicated in this section* shall not exceed the following maximum amounts:
