#### Bill No. 68

An Act to amend the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations to broaden the present five year time limitation on the exercise of special exceptions already granted, by amending subsection 502.3 thereof.

*Whereas*, the amendments to the Zoning Regulations which are contained in this Bill have been formulated in accordance with the procedures specified in Sections 23-20 and 23-21 of the 1966 Cumulative Supplement to the Baltimore County Code, 1958, and the several public hearings required by said sections have been held in accordance therewith; now, therefore:

*Section 1.* BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE COUNTY, MARYLAND, That subsection 502.3 of the Baltimore County Zoning Regulations, 1963, as amended, be and it is hereby amended by deleting the date "July 1, 1965" in the third paragraph thereof and substituting in lieu thereof the date "January 1, ~~1967~~, 1957".

*Section 2.* BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act ~~shall take effect forty five days after its enactment.~~ IS HEREBY DECLARED TO BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE AFFECTING THE PUBLIC HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE AND HAVING BEEN PASSED BY THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF FIVE (5) MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL, THE SAME SHALL TAKE EFFECT FROM THE DATE OF ITS ENACTMENT.
