

(Notary public or other person authorized to administer oaths; commissioned officer, noncommissioned officer, not below the rank of sergeant, or petty officer, other than applicant; if in Merchant Marine, certifying officer may be a master, first officer, chief engineer or purser; or an ambassador, minister, charge d'affaires, counselor to or secretary of a legation, consul general, consul, vice-consul, commercial attache, or consular agent of the United States accredited to the country where the acknowledgment is made; or a notary public of the country where the acknowledgment is made; or a judge or clerk of a court of record of the country where the acknowledgment is made.]

Warning! The Absentee Voting Law provides that anyone who wilfully signs any false application or oath, or who wilfully does any act contrary to the terms and provisions of the Absentee Voting Law with intent to cast an illegal vote or to aid another in doing so, or who wilfully violates any of the provisions of that law or who applies for a ballot under any other name than his own, shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of \$1,000 or to imprisonment for not more than two years, or to both, in the discretion of the court.
