

commissioner shall, not less than thirty days before the commencement of each term of the court at which jurors are required to attend, in the presence of such practicing members of the bar of said court as he shall think proper to attend, select, in accordance with such rules and regulations as determined by the court, not less than two hundred (200) names from the service file, with special reference to the intelligence, sobriety and integrity of such person and without the least reference to their political opinions, race, sex, creed or religion, this list to be known as an annual listing.

(f) When said list of names is selected as directed in Section 9, the procedure in Charles, St. Mary's, and Calvert counties shall be as follows: The clerk of the court shall assign a number to each name on the list ranging from one to three hundred (but not less than one hundred and fifty). Said clerk shall procure a box of suitable size with pellets of uniform size, color, shape and weight. Each pellet shall contain a number thereon corresponding to the numbers on the list above referred to. The clerk shall shake the box and the drawing shall take place in accordance with the provisions of subsection (a), except that the numbers drawn shall be 47. The first 22 pellets so drawn shall determine the selection of the grand jury except for the foreman, and the remaining 25 pellets shall determine the selection of the petit jury, both for the term of event for which the drawing was made. The foreman of the grand jury shall be selected by the court from the panel of names used for such drawing. In the event that a vacancy shall occur in the position of foreman of the grand jury, either temporarily or permanently, by death, absence, sickness or any other cause, the court shall have power to appoint some other member of the grand jury foreman as often as the necessity for such appointment shall occur. If for any reason any person selected as a grand juror shall fail to attend by reason of death, absence, sickness or any other cause, or shall be disqualified or excused from serving, the court may fill such vacancy by drawing the necessary number of additional names in the manner prescribed by this section and by Section [10] 12 of this article.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1969.

CHAPTER 285

(House Bill 314)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Sections 77(c), 161Z(b), 161Z(g) and 274A of Article 23 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1968 Supplement) title "Corporations," subtitles, "Dissolution," "Building or Homestead Associations," and "Religious Corporations," amending the corporation laws of this State in order to make corrections in the laws concerning certain corporations.
