

Orphans' Court, by a court of law. Where such request is made before the Orphans' Court has determined the issue of fact, the Orphans' Court shall transmit the issues to a court of law. After the determination of the issue, whether by the Orphans' Court or after transmission to a court of law, the Orphans' Court shall enter an appropriate judgment or decree. This Section shall not apply where the estate is administered under the jurisdiction of a court having general equity jurisdiction.

SEC. 4. *And be it further enacted,* That the following sections of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition, as from time to time replaced, amended and supplemented) be and they are hereby repealed and reenacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1

(a) Section 5 of Article 1 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1968 Replacement Volume), title "Rules of Interpretation":

5. Whenever the word administrator is used in this Code it shall include executor and personal representative, whenever the word executor is used in this Code it shall include administrator and personal representative, and whenever the words personal representative are used in this Code they shall include administrator and executor, [and so vice versa], unless such an application of [the term] such terms would be unreasonable.
