VOTE AMONG THEM, TO BE CAST BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OR HIS DESIGNEE. Additionally, the Maryland Department of Economic Development and the Maryland State Planning Department, shall each be represented on the Council by one non-voting member.

52A.

(a) There is hereby established a tri-county body to be known as the Tri-County Council for Southern Maryland to represent the counties of Calvert, Charles and St. Mary's. Membership in the Council will consist of the State Senators and Delegates representing Calvert, Charles and St. Mary's Counties in addition to four additional members from each county to be elected by the Council and to include a representative of the County Commissioners of the County Planning and Zoning Commission and of the County Economic Development Commission six additional members from each county to include three County Commissioners, a member of the County Planning and Zoning Commission, a member of the County Economic Development Commission and a member at large. THE THREE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS SHALL HAVE BUT ONE VOTE AMONG THEM, TO BE CAST BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OR HIS DESIGNEE. Additionally, the Maryland Department of Economic Development and the Maryland State Planning Department shall each be represented on the Council by one non-voting member.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted. That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1970.

## CHAPTER 454

(Senate Bill 789)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 123A of the Code of Public Local Laws of Calvert County (1963 Edition, being Article 5 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Calvert County," subtitle "County Commissioners," as last amended by Chapter 584 of the Acts of 1966; to repeal and reenact, with amendments, Section 56 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Charles County (1969 Edition, being Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "Charles County," subtitle "County Commissioners," subheading "Miscellaneous Appropriations," to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 41 of the Code of Public Local Laws of St. Mary's County (1968 Supplement, being Article 19 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland), title "St. Mary's County," subtitle "County Commissioners," to change the name of the "Tri-County Committee for Community Action" and to provide for more flexibility in the purposes of the Council by redefining their functions.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 123A of the Code of Public Local Laws of Calvert
