(a) The members of the Authority shall from time to time elect a chairman from among their own members. The Authority shall meet at the call of the chairman, the Secretary of Economic and Community Development, or of any four members thereof. They may adopt bylaws covering their organization and procedure.

61.

(k) The Authority, subject to approval by the Secretary of Economic and Community Development, shall have the power to make such reasonable rules and regulations and to do such reasonable acts as may be necessary to carry out the intent of this subtitle.

63.

The Authority, subject to approval by the Secretary of Economic and Community Development, may employ an executive secretary treasurer and such other employees, agents, or experts as it determines to be for the best interests of the Authority, and fix the compensation and conditions of employment of any such persons, subject to the previsions of the budget. It may, subject to approval by the Secretary of Economic and Community Development, rent, lease or buy office space, and purchase supplies and equipment as it deems necessary.

64.

The Authority, subject to approval by the Secretary of Economic and Community Development, shall appoint such number of inspectors as it shall determine to enforce the duties imposed upon it by law, or to enforce the rules and regulations established by it pursuant to this subtitle. The Authority, subject to approval by the Secretary of Economic and Community Development, shall prescribe their powers and duties, and the inspectors shall receive such compensation as shall be provided in the budget of the Authority.

Sec. 12. And be it further enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 72, 73(a), (d), 80 of Article 97 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1957 Edition, 1964 Replacement Volume), title "Weights and Measures," subtitle "State Apple Commission" be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

72.

There is hereby ereated, within the State [Board of Agriculture] Department of Economic and Community Development an agency to be known as the Maryland State Apple Commission, consisting of seven members representing as nearly as possible the important apple producing sections of the State. Such Commission shall be appointed by the Scoretary of Economic and Community Development, with the approval of the Covernor, from a list of two eligible growers for each member to be appointed which list shall be supplied the [Covernor] Scoretary of Economic and Community Development by the executive committee of the Maryland State Horticultural
