- (h) Members of the several boards shall receive compensation as follows:
 - (1) Caroline County—Five hundred dollars per annum.
- (1A) Garrett County—Eighteen hundred dollars (\$1,800.00) per annum, with a mileage fee of ten cents (10ϕ) per mile when in attendance upon meetings.
- (2) Harford County—Twelve FIFTEEN hundred dollars per annum, provided that an additional compensation shall be paid board members for administrative services.
- (3) Kent County—Fifteen dollars (\$15.00) for each day they meet on official business.
- (4) Montgomery County—The salary of the director of the department of liquor control shall be fixed by the county manager with the approval of the County Council.
- (5) Somerset County—One thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) per annum.
- (6) Wicomico County—Nine hundred dollars per annum, and a salary of three hundred dollars per annum for the chairman of the board, in addition to and over and above such compensation prescribed herein for members of the said board.
- (7) Worcester County—[Twelve hundred] Fifteen hundred (\$1,500.00) per annum, with a mileage fee of ten cents per mile when in attendance upon meetings.
- SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1970.

CHAPTER 631

(House Bill 1219)
