- (3) Selling proprietary or patent medicines.
- (4) Practicing as an optician.
- (5) Massage by hand, or other manipulation by hand but by no other means.
- (6) Practicing any profession otherwise registered, certified or licensed and defined by law.
- 120. The Board of Medical Examiners—Establishment.

The Board of Medical Examiners of the State of Maryland is hereby established, as part of the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene.

- (1) It shall consist of eight members elected by the Medical and Chirurgical Faculty of the State of Maryland at its annual meeting. TWO MEMBERS TO BE ELECTED BY THE FACULTY EACH YEAR. THEIR TERMS SHALL COMMENCE FIRST DAY OF JUNE NEXT FOLLOWING THEIR ELECTION. THE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS OF THE STATE OF MARYLAND, AS CONSTITUTED ON JUNE 30, 1970, SHALL CONTINUE AS CONSTITUTED AT THAT TIME, WITH EACH MEMBER SERVING FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE TIME FOR WHICH HE WAS SELECTED.
- (2) The members shall be physicians practicing medicine in the State of Maryland.
- (3) A majority of the members of the Board constitutes a quorum.
- (4) The members shall serve a four-year term and may succeed themselves.
- (5) Two members shall be elected by the Faculty each year. The terms shall commence on the first day of June next following the election of the member.
- (6) (5) In the event of a vacancy, the Board shall select a new member to serve until his successor, elected at the next annual meeting of the Faculty, takes office. TO SERVE FOR THE REMAINDER OF SUCH UNEXPIRED TERM.
- (7) (6) The Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE BOARD OF MEDICAL EXAMINERS may remove any member of the Board for eause. NEGLECT OF DUTY, MISCONDUCT, OR MALFEASANCE OR MISFEASANCE IN OFFICE.
- 121. The Board of Medical Examiners—Powers and Duties.

The Board has the following powers and duties:

- (a) (1) Establish and administer examinations to be taken by applicants for license to practice medicine in the State of Maryland.
- (b) (2) Establish such other qualifications of applicants as it deems advisable for license to practice medicine.
- (e) (3) License qualified applicants to practice medicine in the State of Maryland.
