4. The effective date of the Charter Amendment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of College Park be, and is specifically enjoined and instructed to carry out the provisions of Sections 2 and 3, above, as evidence of compliance herewith; the said Mayor shall cause to be affixed to the Minutes of this meeting:

- 1. An appropriate certificate of publication of the newspaper in which the title of this Resolution shall have been published; and
- 2. Return receipts of the mailing referred to in Section 3, and shall further complete and execute the Certificate of Effect attached hereto.
