The award shall be signified by an appropriate insignia to be displayed on the left forearm sleeve of the recipient's uniform (WHERE APPLICABLE); such insignia shall be used for no other purpose.

(C) PATROLMAN WILLIAM J. BOWERS, JR., OF THE ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY POLICE DEPARTMENT, HAVING RISKED HIS LIFE ON OR ABOUT JUNE 8, 1969 IN A CERTAIN BOMBING INCIDENT, IS HEREBY AWARDED THE DISTINGUISHED SERVICE AWARD OF ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY, AND SHALL BE PAID THE ANNUAL SUM OF FIVE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$500.00) IN ADDITION TO HIS SALARY, SUCH PAYMENT TO CONTINUE DURING HIS LIFETIME.

Section 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the name of said Subtitle 6, "Vandalism", of said Code and Title, is hereby repealed and recodified under the new name of "Subtitle 6, Rewards and Citations".

Section 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Ordinance shall take effect forty-five (45) days from the date it becomes law.
