(4) SAID RESOLUTION SHALL BE PASSED BY THE AFFIRM-ATIVE VOTE OF NOT LESS THAN FIVE (5) MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL.

Section 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency ordinance and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, welfare, and property, and being passed by the affirmative vote of five (5) members of the County Council, the same shall take effect from the date it becomes law.
