its full faith and credit for roads, streets, highways, curbs, sidewalks, storm drainage, and all related construction pertinent thereto, and prescribing the terms and conditions, by reference, upon which said bonds shall be issued and delivered and other incidental details with respect thereto, and providing for the application of the proceeds of such bonds and for the levy of unlimited ad valorem taxes for the payment of the principal and interest thereof.

Be It Enacted by the County Council for Montgomery County, Maryland, that—

Section 1. Montgomery County, Maryland, is hereby authorized at any time and from time to time, upon its full faith and credit to borrow money and incur indebtedness in a total amount not exceeding \$7,200,000 for financing the construction, improvement, repair, opening, relocation, grading, resurfacing, widening, extension and drainage of all public roads, streets, highways and sidewalks in the County now or hereafter maintained and operated by or under the jurisdiction of the County, including the acquisition of necessary rights-of-way, the acquisition of equipment for highway construction, maintenance and repair and planning and engineering services; the planning, design, construction and reconstruction of free bridges constituting parts of such roads, streets or highways; the planning, construction, repair and permanent improvement of any storm water drainage system necessary in the County.

Section 2. Sections 2-111 through 2-119 inclusive, of the Montgomery County Code 1965, as amended, and each and every part of such sections, excepting therefrom only subsections (a), (c) and (d) of Section 2-111, be and they are hereby incorporated in this Act, by reference, as a part hereof, it being the intention of the County Council that said sections shall be applicable in all respects to the borrowing of money, the issuance of bonds, the application of the proceeds of such bonds, and the levy of unlimited ad valorem taxes for the payment of the principal and interest of the bonds authorized by this Act.

Section 3. The powers granted by this Act are additional and cumulative and the bonds authorized by this Act may be issued notwithstanding that other bond acts or laws may provide for the issuance of other bonds or the borrowing of money for the same or similar purposes on the same or other terms and conditions.

Section 4. This Act shall take effect on the 76th day following its enactment.
