CHAPTER 222

(House Bill 1286)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 5(I)(2) (c) of Chapter 435 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 1968 to provide for a change to a project authorized in the General Construction Loan of 1968 for renovation of a farm building to be used as a vocational rehabilitation building.

CHAPTER 223

(House Bill 1292)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 49(a) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1968 Replacement Volume), title "Alcoholic Beverages," subtitle "General Provisions on Issue of Licenses," to allow tentative approval of liquor license prior to completion of building in Howard County.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 49(a) of Article 2B of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1968 Replacement Volume), title "Alcoholic Beverages," subtitle "General Provisions on Issue of Licenses," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
