

place and manner of awarding bonds so bid for, including the right whenever any of the bonds authorized by this Act are offered for sale and sold at the same time as other bonds of said corporation, to establish the conditions for bids and awards and to award all of said bonds on an all or none basis; and the time, place, terms and manner of settlement for the bonds so bid for.

The ordinance to be submitted to the legal voters of Baltimore City, or the resolution of the Commissioners of Finance authorizing the issuance of said bonds, or any portion thereof, as the case may be, shall set forth in detail the dates when any of the bonds are to mature and the amount to mature upon such dates.

SEC. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That the actual cash proceeds derived from the sale of the bonds authorized to be issued under the provisions of this Act, not exceeding the par value thereof, shall be used exclusively for the following purposes, to wit:

(a) So much thereof as may be necessary, in addition to the premiums realized from the sale, if any, for the cost of issuance, including the expense of engraving, printing, advertising, attorney's fees, and all other incidental expenses connected therewith; and

(b) The remainder of the proceeds shall be used for the acquisition, by purchase, condemnation or any other legal means, of land or property, or any rights therein, in the City of Baltimore, and constructing and erecting on said land or property, or on any land or property now or hereafter owned by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore, new Enoch Pratt Free Library Branch Buildings and other auxiliary facilities, and for additions and improvements to, or the reconstruction of, existing Enoch Pratt Free Library Buildings, and for the reconstruction, renovation, modernization or improvement of any buildings or structures now or hereafter owned by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore and to be used to house the functions or activities of the Enoch Pratt Free Library System, and for the purchase, acquisition, installation and erection of any and all kinds of furniture and equipment for any and all of the new facilities authorized to be constructed, erected or acquired by the provisions hereof, and for the purchase, acquisition, installation and erection of any and all kinds of library or auxiliary equipment for the Enoch Pratt Free Library System or for alterations to, or the replacement of, any such existing equipment now being used by, or in connection with, the Enoch Pratt Free Library System; and for doing any and all things necessary, proper or expedient in connection with or pertaining to any or all of the matters or things hereinbefore mentioned.

SEC. 4. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, and having been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by three-fifths of the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly of Maryland, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.
