CHAPTER 354 (House Bill 723)

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact, with amendments, Section 32 of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1969 Replacement Volume), title "Revenue and Taxes," subtitle "Levy," to provide that the county commissioners of Charles County shall hold a public hearing concerning the rate of county taxation and the county commissioners shall set the tax rate before June 1, of each year.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 32 of Article 81 of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1969 Replacement Volume), title "Revenue and Taxes," subtitle "Levy," be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

32.

As soon as may be practicable after the date of finality in each year and in any event before the first day of July next following the county commissioners of each county and the mayor and city council of Baltimore or any other city shall fix the rate of county or city taxation for such ensuing year on all assessments, persons or property subject to taxation under this article in such county or city and for which the rate is not fixed by this article; but, however, in Charles County the county commissioners shall hold a public hearing concerning the rate of county taxation on all assessments, persons or property subject to taxation under this article and as soon as may be practicable after the date of finality in each year and in any event before the first day of June next following; provided that where any fixed or limited rate of county and/or city taxes is prescribed by this article, such county and/or city taxes are hereby levied at such respective rates upon all assessments, persons and property liable thereto under the provisions of this article, and it shall not be necessary for the county commissioners of any county or the authorities of any city to pass any resolution or ordinance levying the same.

SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect on July 1, 1970.
