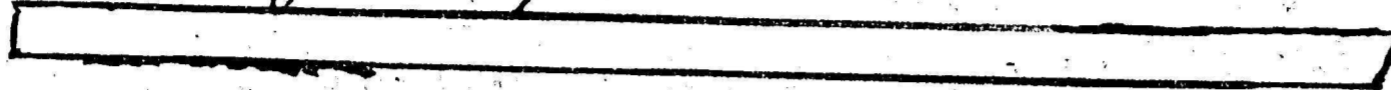

This Indenture made the second day of February  
in the year of our Lord God One thousand seven hundred  
Twenty four Between Benjamin Williams of Ann Arundel  
County planter & Margaret his wife of the one part and Joseph  
Williams of the said County planter of the other part Witness both  
that they the said Benjamin Williams & Margaret his  
wife doo for and in consideration of the sum of five Shillings  
current monoy of Maryland to them in hand paid also  
for the naturall Love & affection they bear unto the said  
Joseph Williams their son and that he hath hitherto in all  
respects demeaned himselfe obediently dutifull and also for  
divers <sup>other</sup> good causes & valuable consideration then therunto  
Especially moving Have Given Granted bargained sold  
aliened enfeoffed & made over as by these presents they the  
Benjamin Williams & Margaret his wife doo forthom selves &  
their heirs Give Grant bargain sell alien enfeoff confirm &  
make over unto him the said Joseph Williams his heirs &  
assignes for ever All those tracts or parcels of Land here in after  
Expressed that is to say All y<sup>e</sup> tract or parcel of Land called  
Williams Contrivance containing three hundred & twenty  
seven Acres Originally laid out for the said Benjamin  
Williams on or about the twenty third day of February sixteen  
hundred & ninety nine also one other tract of Land called y<sup>e</sup>  
Addition containing One hundred & sixty six acres Originally
