 granted bargained sold aliened released sufficed and confirmed
 and every part and parcel thereof w^{ch} their Appurtenances
 unto and to the use of the said William Stavely and James Bennett
 their heirs and assigns for ever. Be it by Deed or Deeds enrolled
 or not enrolled the enrollment of these presents or by any
 other lawfull and reasonable ways or means whatsoever
 as by the said William Stavely and James Bennett their
 heirs or assigns or their or any of their Council learned in
 the Law shall be reasonably devised or advised and required
 so as the party or parties that shall be required to make
 such further Assurance or Assurances be not compelled for
 the making or doing thereof to travel further than the
 Cities of London and Westminster, or one of them. In
