

This indenture made this 22<sup>d</sup> Day of November Anno Domini  
 Seventeen hundred and Twenty five Between Henry Pateman  
 of Annamundell County Carpenter of the One part and Samuel  
 Peale of the same County Merchant on the other part Witnesseth  
 that the said Henry for and in consideration of the Sum of forty  
 pounds Sterling to him the said Henry by him the said Samuel in  
 hand paid the receipt whereof he the said Henry doth hereby  
 acknowledge and therefrom and from every part and parcel thereof  
 doth hereby fully clearly and absolutely acquit honor and  
 discharge him the said Samuel his heirs Executors and Administra-  
 tors hath given granted bargained sold Aligned enfeoffed and  
 confirmed and both by these presents for himself his heirs  
 given grant bargained sell aliene <sup>enfeoffe</sup> and confirm unto him  
 said Samuel Peale his heirs and assigns for ever All that Tract  
 or parcel of Land called Welch's Adventure conveyed for  
 Daniel Welsh about the year sixteen hundred Eighty Eight  
 and by the said Daniel or his heirs conveyed to Otho Holland  
 and by the said Otho conveyed to the said Henry Pateman  
 party to these presents situated lying & being in Trallemore  
 County Between Givins Falls and Jones Falls of Potapscow River  
 beginning at a bounded white Oak standing at the head of a  
 branch called the north East Branch of the three branched  
 pond and running thence Down the Branch South five degrees  
 East One hundred and twenty Eight perches unto a bounded Red Oak  
 then West five degrees South One hundred and twenty eight ps  
 unto a bounded White Oak then north five degrees West One  
 hundred and Twenty Eight perches unto a double bounded Red  
 Oak South a straight line to the first bounded Tree (containing)  
 and laid out for One hundred and Two Acres more or less  
 (with)
