 presents he the said Stephen Gill doth for himself and his  
 heirs Give Grant Bargain Sell Alien Enfeoffe Confirme  
 and make over unto him of said William portney his heirs  
 and Assignes for ever All that tract or parcels of Land -  
 Called Walnut Neck lying on the middle branch of Patuxent  
 River originally laid out for Hugh Henfy on or about  
 the eighteenth day of August One thousand six hundred
