 means of his the said Jonathan his Killing himselfe
 or being the Cause of his Own Death as fully Clearly
 and amply as if the said Jonathan had Dyed a
 Naturall Death Provided never the loss that these
 presents shall not hurt Injure or prejudice any of
 The Creditors Children or other representatives of the
 Deed but that all and Singular his Goods and Chattles
 Rights and Credits shall be Lyable to the same pay-
 ments Burthens Charges and Distributions as the per-
 sonall Estator of persons Dyeng Naturall Deaths and
 Intestates are Lyable unto any thing herein to the con-
 trary Notwithstanding. Witness our Selves and well

 Governour in Chiefe in and Over Our said province of
 Maryland at the City of Annapolis this Seventh Day
