Then came William Greaves party to w<sup>ch</sup> in indentures and acknowledged w<sup>ch</sup> in deed and w<sup>ch</sup> land & premises therein mentioned to God Right of J<sup>ts</sup> Thomas Gosting his heirs and assigns forever by vertue thereof and at y<sup>e</sup> same time Ann y<sup>e</sup> wife of J<sup>ts</sup> Wm Greaves being by us privately examined out of y<sup>e</sup> hearing of her husband acknowledged her right of Dowry therein which she declared she did willingly & freely w<sup>th</sup> out being induced thereto by fear or ill usage by her husband or fear of his displeasure
