Acquitt & Discharge of the said James Nuttall his heirs & Assignes  
Administrators & Assignes for ever By these presents hath given  
granted Bargained Alien'd Sold Infeoff'd & Confirmed & by these  
presents doth fully & clearly & absolutely give grant Bargaine  
Sell Alien Infeoff & Confirms unto him the said James Nuttall  
his heirs & Assignes for ever all that parcel or tract of Land w<sup>ch</sup>
