

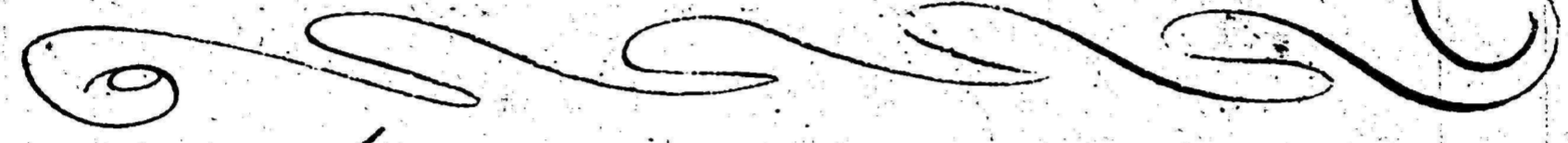
On the back of the foregoing Deed was Endowt as follows viz

This Indenture made the fourth day of April in the 38th
 year of y^e Dominion of Charles Absolute Lord & Proprietary
 of the Province of Maryland & Avalon Lord Baron of Baltimore
 of the County of St. Maries in the Province of
 Maryland Gent of y^e one part & James Nutthall of y^e same County
 & Province of y^e planters of the other part Witnesseth that
 the s^d John Nutthall for y^e Consideration of twelve thousand
 pounds of good tobacco and Cash to him in hand paid by the said
 James Nutthall of y^e Receipt whereof the said John Nutthall doth
 hereby Acknowledge and thereof and of every part & Deal there-
 of doth absolutely & clearly Exonerate Acquitt & Discharge
 y^e s^d James Nutthall his heirs Executors Administrators & Assignes
 for ever By these presents hath y^e s^d James Nutthall Bargained
 Alien'd Sold Enfeoff'd & Confirmed & by these presents doth
 fully Clearly & Absolutely Give Grant Bargaine & Sell Alien
 Enfeoffe & Confirm unto him the said James Nutthall his heirs
 & Assignes for ever all y^e parcel or tract of Land w^{ch} he y^e said
 James Nutthall now lewth or being part of a Deed out of Land
 Commonly knowne or Called by the name of Cornwallis Crofs
 Mannor Situated lying & being in St. Maries County afo^r the w^{ch}
 bounds of the said tract or parcel of Land Beginneth at y^e Quarter
 Creek & Runneth along by the side of the old field y^e y^e Crofs
 Mannor howe it standeth onto the pathway y^e goeth to the long
 Neck & from thence along the said path till it Cometh to John
