Waller Hall or his true and Lawfull Attorney Executors Admors & assigns by way of payment well and truly to be made Doe bindeme my Heirs Exors & Admrs firmly by these presents sealed wth my Seal and Dated the twenty first Day of April in the eighth and thirtieth year of Facilius & Annoq^{uo} Domini 1727

The Condition of this obligation is such that if the above bound John Nutthall his Heirs Exors or Admrs shall for his or their parts well and truly hold observe & performe fullfill and keep all and singular covenants Grants Articles & Agreements of any part and behalf of said John Nutthall are to be holden observed performed fullfilled Done and kept contained & specified in certain pair of indentures bearing Date & Day of Date hereof made between said John Nutthall of one part and of above named Walter Hall of the other part of this Obligation to be void and of none effect or Use to stand remaine and abide in full force power and Virtue
